**NOW THEREFORE I,**

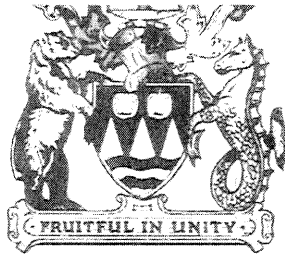

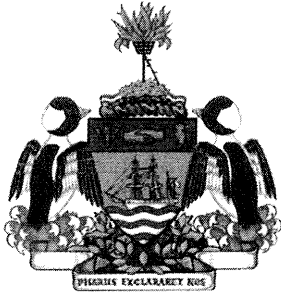
